It is the policy of the Wellington Catholic District School Board to provide programs and put into place measures that respond to the needs of Aboriginal students. All Aboriginal students and their parents have the right to voluntarily self-identify, a process that will provide the necessary data to inform the Board about specific program needs for Aboriginal students. It is through this voluntary identification process that the Board will establish a process to collect and aggregate student achievement data for Aboriginal students. This collection of Aboriginal student achievement data will provide the Board with relevant information to develop appropriate strategies to meet the goals established for Aboriginal education in the Wellington Catholic District School Board.
