The Wellington Catholic District School Board strives to maintain safe and secure learning environments and to protect resources in its care.

The use of video security surveillance systems supports the Board's policy governing Safe Schools and its responsibility as a publicly funded organization. Deterrence is one of the benefits of a surveillance system.

Information collected through a surveillance system places a duty on the Board to protect the personal privacy of individuals. The District recognizes its duties under legislation including the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act which imposes obligations with respect to collection, use, disclosure, retention, security and disposal of personal information.
